Starting from Lonavala, the trek to Rajmachi Fort covers a distance of approximately 16 kilometers. The trail takes you through dense forests, lush green meadows, and picturesque landscapes, providing a refreshing escape from the hustle and bustle of city life. As you trek towards the base village of Udhewadi, you will be greeted by the twinkling lights of fireflies, especially around sunset. This natural phenomenon, known as bioluminescence, is a sight to behold and offers a perfect setting for photography enthusiasts

Rajmachi Fort itself is a historical marvel, consisting of two forts - Shrivardhan and Manaranjan. Built by Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj in the 17th century, these forts offer panoramic views of the surrounding valleys and the Borghat pass. The trek not only provides an opportunity to witness the fireflies but also to explore these ancient forts and learn about their historical significance. The combination of natural beauty and historical exploration makes the Rajmachi Fireflies Trek a memorable experience

For those starting from Pune, the journey involves a drive to Lonavala followed by the trek to Rajmachi.
